Description

270pp, [2]. Original half pigskin and buckram over boards, raised bands, spine in six panels, title in gilt to second panel, cockerel device to fifth, t.e.g., remainder untrimmed. Spine slightly rubbed, usual light foxing to cloth covers, internally bright and clean. Bookplate of Victor Alberts to front pastedown. Number three hundred and thirty-three of five hundred copies on paper (with another twelve on vellum). Binding is by Sangorski and Sutcliffe. In the original slipcase which has Japanese paper repairs to edges and corners. The Four Gospels is widely regarded as one of the best private press books.
