

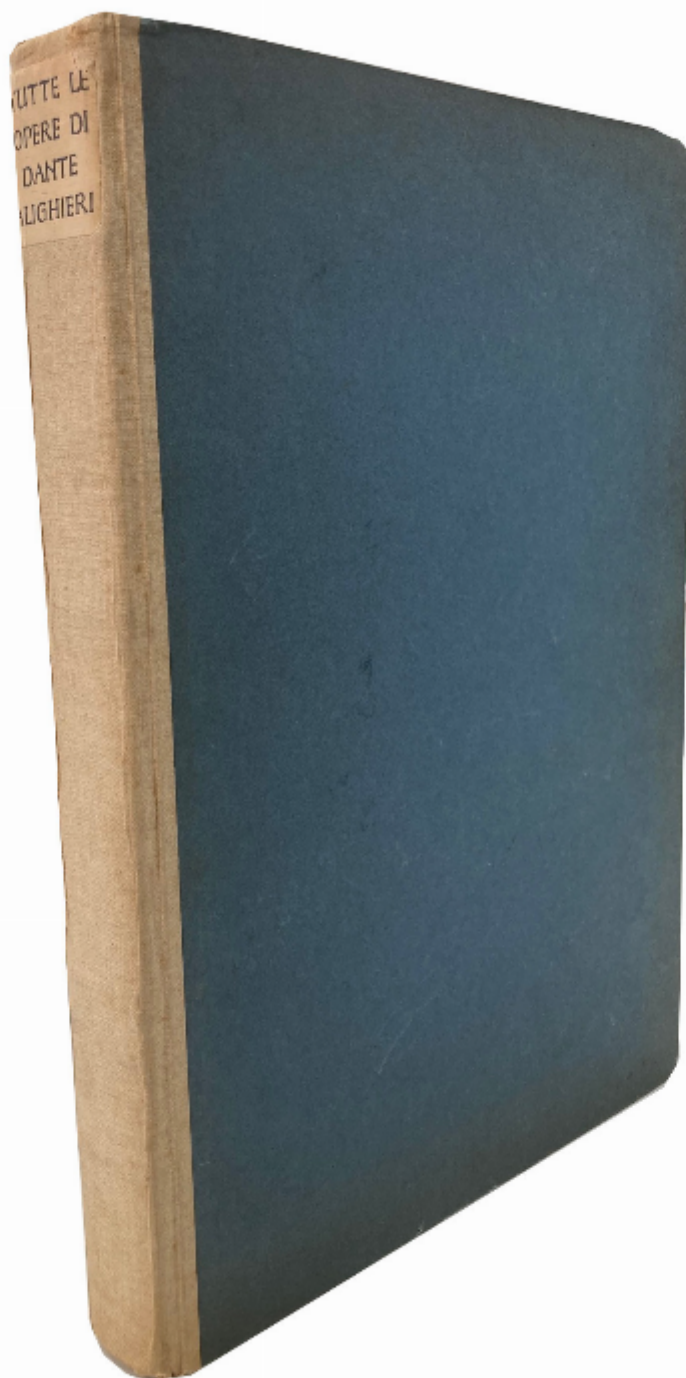

Label slightly chipped with a little loss to edges, minor creases to spine, corners gently bumped, internally sporadic light foxing, but generally fairly clean and bright. One of 111 copies, this being one of 105 copies on paper, printed in double column, in Subiaco type, with full-page woodcut frontispiece and five large woodcuts in the text by W. H. Hooper after Charles M. Gere, three smaller diagrammatic illustrations in the text, headings and shoulder notes in red, large initials in red designed by Graily Hewitt. Presentation copy from St. John Hornby to the Italian-British scholar Linetta de Castelveccchio (1880-1975) who produced an Italian revision of William Warren Vernon's *Dante* in 1908, with the inscription 'A L. de Castelveccchio dono dello Stampatore C.H.
